ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

On Saturday, 23rd March 2024, we gathered to celebrate and give thanks for what God enabled us to achieve in the year 2023.

We were joined by our East Africa regional director, Luc Dushimerugaba, International board vice chair, Nthenya Macharia, the national board, trustees, staff, volunteers and friends of Kenya YFC.

We celebrated God's divine guidance that led us to reach 58,373 students in 18 counties with the gospel of Jesus Christ. **11,021** of them gave their lives to Christ, and **4,607** were discipled. Our team grew from 15 to 35 members, and we launched a new chapter in Malindi that, among other ways, engages the youth through sports. We've also supported three girls from our Kimbilio shelter to go back to school, one being in Daystar University and the other two in Highschool and helped teen moms start their own businesses.

Every smile captured in our photos reflects the blessings we've received and will continue to receive as the Lord works through us.
