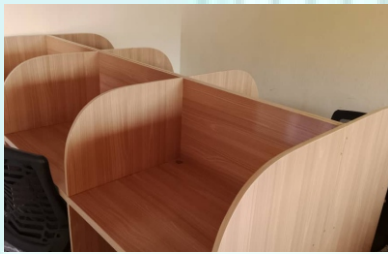

In order to diversify our funding source, the National Office has established a Co-Work Space and Startup Incubation Hub, the first of its kind in Kubwa community. We also entered into a training partnership with CSED Ltd/GTE which provides support to Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises. Ten YFC volunteers already benefited in their training.

The resignation of 4 of our key staff affected our ministry in the year, especially in Minna, Agbara-Lagos, Jalingo, and Abuja. It also hindered our plan for pioneering of 2 new Centres: Ibadan and Makurdi. We had to deploy 2 of the new staff to Minna and Agbara to stabilize the ministry in the Centres.

We are grateful to God for access to speak to, and train adults in churches, to personally reach, disciple and mentor 3-5 At-Risk young people in their communities.



We trust God for more churches granting permission to raise and train more adults as youth disciplers and mentors across Nigeria.



One of the numerous stories of impact is Amina's. From being a bitter kola seller by the roadside, with no hope or continuing her education, 16 year old Amina found momentum in her spiritual life and academic pursuits through the ministry of Youth for Christ.

She accepted Jesus in to her life, and began attending the G21 school of Leadership and Discipleship. YFC provided her with school materials, helped her enrol into school and continues to monitor her progress through the journey.



In Minna Centre, an Islamic cleric, impressed by YFC's transformative work in the lives of the young people in his neighbourhood, enrolled his children in the G21 Tutorial Lessons and School of Leadership.

Also, the LEAD Academy organized during the summer vacation in Abuja, had close to 100 students. A 13-year-old student; Obae Precious, as a result of the training initiated a G21 Club to teach other young people in her community. This is a testimony of the lasting impact of YFC's leadership trainings.



We have high hopes for 2024! God has instructed us to ASCEND to the high mountains and SHINE His light to the young people of Nigeria!

We are ascending in the place of prayer and the word, and we are shining the light of the Gospel to every young person in every people group in Nigeria, as far as the Lord will enable us!
