### Description

The Community Director works together with others to establish in the international community a relational presence that demonstrates and communicates the love and joy of Jesus Christ to young people and their families. YouthCompass' vision is young people in every international community given the opportunity to respond to Jesus Christ.

To implement the YouthCompass Vision and Mission in the community as follows:

1. Direct the YouthCompass outreach ministry at the middle school and high school levels. This includes contact work, Bible Study, one-on-one discipling, area-wide youth events, camps and work projects.
2. Recruit, train, and supervise additional YouthCompass and/or volunteer staff (as applicable).
3. Develop and/or ensure the maintenance of a local community support group. This community support group helps guide and support the YouthCompass effort and takes leadership in international community fund raising and public relations efforts. It is intended that this local community support group will take community ownership of the ministry, leading to legal incorporation as applicable.
4. Be accountable and respond to the input and direction of the local community support group.
5. Interface as needed with the local and national authorities, i.e. work permits, visas, taxes etc. in cooperation with the local community support group.
6. Develop and maintain relationships with local Christian church leaders in the community and participate in church partnerships (as applicable).
7. Represent YouthCompass to the community and, in conjunction with the local community support group, ensure effective public relations with school officials, parents and others. Participate with the local community support group in local fundraising projects.
8. Participate in regional planning and growth conferences and assist with camps and other activities at the regional level.
9. Accountable to the YouthCompass Regional Director through regular reports, meetings, correspondence, etc. regarding the quality of local YouthCompass ministry, the conduct of staff, and any additional support needs.
10. Fundraise for the ministry of YFCI. This includes meeting and connecting donors to YFCI

### Qualifications

- Youth ministry staff experience or equivalent, preferably a minimum of five years
- Must have either a 4 year degree and/or relevant ministry experience
- Must be at least 18 years or older
